Posh Sunflower (5+ designs)

**Sew Kind of Wonderful's patchwork pattern
their freemotion designs - digitised by Sharon Perry**



This little quilt is made up of 3.5 inch blocks and is very densely quilted adding wonderful texture – it is absolutely stunning.

This set does NOT include any quilting designs for the blue background. This area has lines echoing around the outers of the main design.

The quilting designs are drawn to scale but are not exactly the same as SKoW to make them more computer machine friendly.

When free-motion quilting it is a good idea to ditch stitch first in order to stabilise the quilt. I would NOT advise this when using computerised designs.

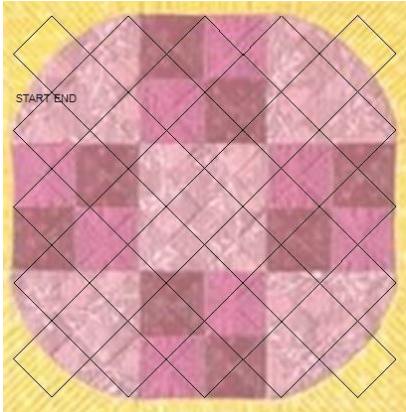
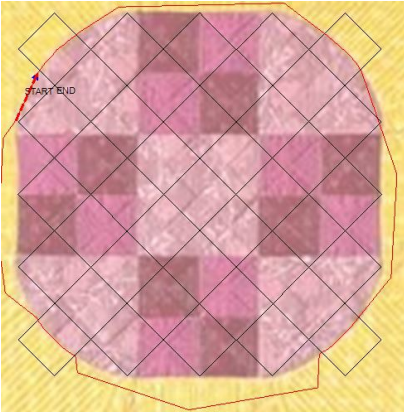
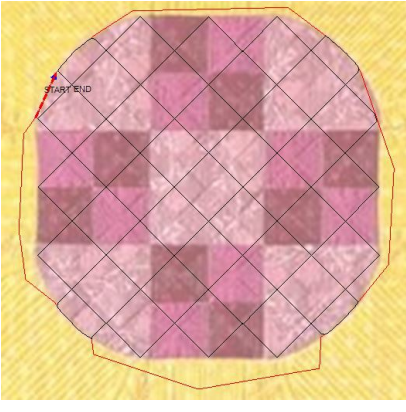
If you are wanting to ditch stitch – leave it till LAST. That way you will be able to do some fabric manipulation should it be required.

There are p2p and p2psu designs in this set – and they ALL use the corners of the blocks to register – not the piecing intersections within a block. See illustrations.

In addition, it would be advisable to outline the shape and check that the designs are being placed accurately.

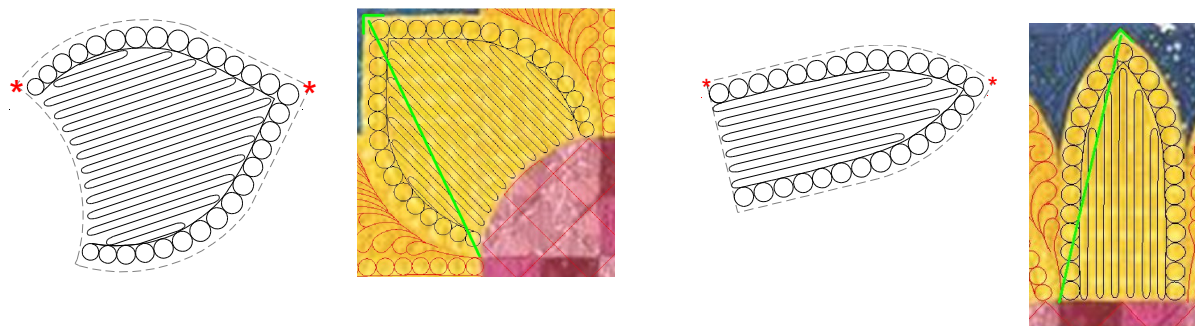
Flower Centre - fill inside

For this area I would use a 5x5 cross hatch. It is different to what SKoW did, but it works well. There will be very little stitching needing to be done right on the piecing boundary.

		
Size it (just under 10.5") so that the top, bottom and sides are just within the pieced area. There will be just a few lines in each of the corners which extend beyond.	Create a boundary around the outside of the area – but <u>exactly</u> on the boundary between the centre and the petals in the corners. This is going to be a stitching line. Everywhere else does not have to be exact.	Make sure the boundary is active (red) – press the trim outside icon. Stitch out and remove the boundary. (you may have to make it red again to do so).

The remaining designs are all placed using the p2p function, even if they are not truly p2p designs. The registration points are corners of the 3.5" squares – even if the designs do not sew out into those corners. This is for placement accuracy.

Petals with circles



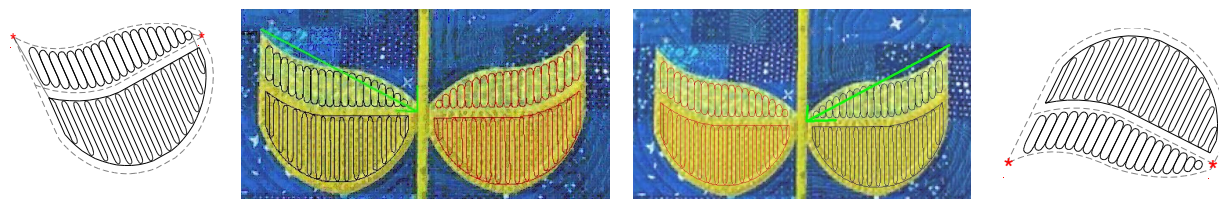
Petals with feathers

There is a left and right design (the right is a mirror or flipped of the left)



Tiny Leaves

These are small and easy to get placed slightly 'off', so do do an outline and just check before sewing out.
