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a Kitchen Table Quilting's patchwork pattern

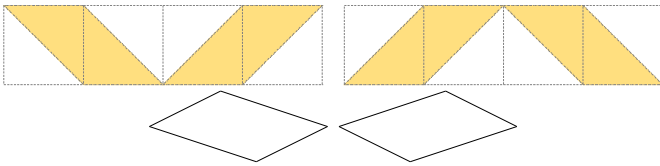
Some ideas for custom quilting this fabulous quilt using Sharon's digitised designs on longarm quilting machines.

This quilt is made from half square triangles (hst). If the hst's are large – it leaves much room for the quilting to really show. If small then custom quilting still gives the quilt a special look, just use less dense designs.

Many different combinations of designs are available depending on the quilt and customer you have before you! Even use different triangles in the dark areas to the light.



The anatomy of the blocks and how to use different types of patterns



Parallelograms: Whether you put the quilt on the machine the orientation shown above – or 'upside down' the required orientation of the parallelograms will be the same.

So long as the design is for a parallelogram made up of 2 hst's – flip/mirror (from side or rotate (180° at a time) your designs to achieve the rotations – and then save the two required. They can then be sewn continuously one after the other (concatenated)

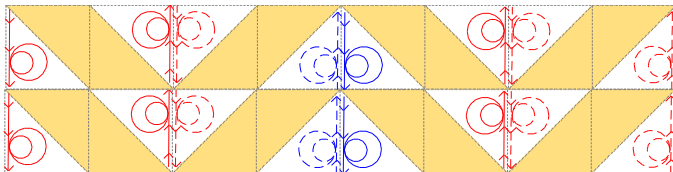
Look at Chevron designs – they are made up of two parallelograms sewn one after the other. They may be a bit hard to split though if they are combined..

For the hst's, look at Flying Geese designs – there are often many suitable ones there.

same sized p2p half square triangles (p2p along a side of the triangle)

Flipped/mirrored version of each design will be required. If not supplied, save any versions you make.

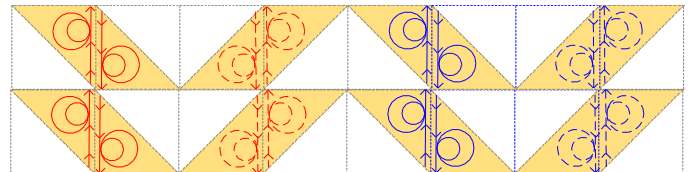
Travel between rows is possible – up and down as far as the machine bed allows. The up requires the flipped/mirrored version of the down.



same sized p2p half square triangles (p2p along a side of the triangle)

Flipped/mirrored version of each parallelogram design (depending on its orientation) will be required. If not supplied, save any versions you make.

Travel between rows is possible – up and down as far as the machine bed allows.



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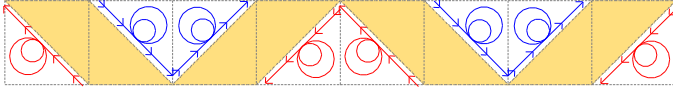
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a Kitchen Table Quilting's patchwork pattern

same sized triangles standard tp2p triangles

(p2p across the base) this shows the maximum length of continuous sewing.

Travel between rows is not possible



same sized triangles standard p2p triangles

(p2p across the base)

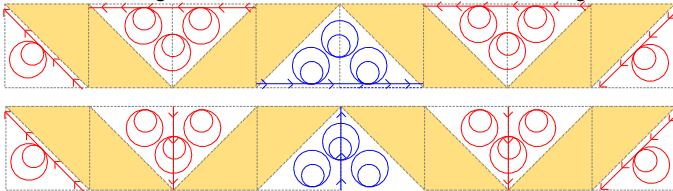
The coloured arrows show the maximum length of continuous sewing. First the red, stop, then the blue, stop

Travel between rows is not possible.



mix of different sized p2p triangles

can be either p2p across the base or from center base to tip (the latter can sew continuously from row to row).
hst triangles could also be used in the side triangles.

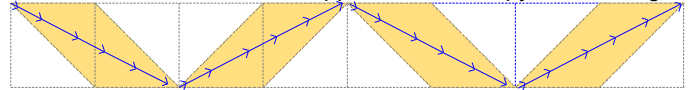


p2p parallelograms

Sort of a diamond, but not quite (diamonds have their side angles halfway up the length of the diamond).
If the start/finish points of the design is at the tips - can be sewn continuously across the whole width.

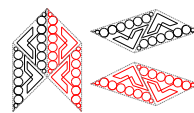
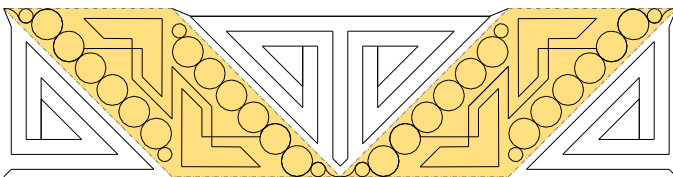
Just check that there is not too much takeup if the design is dense. Perhaps only set one half the width at once.

You need to have/create a flipped/mirrored copy of the design..

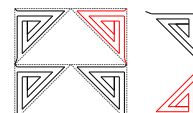

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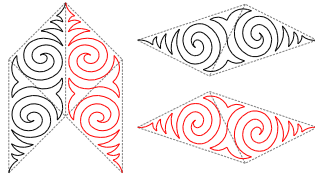
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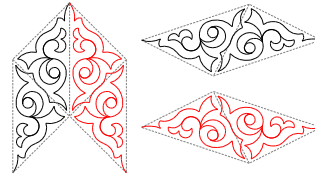
Some other options - there may be more added – filter for

 - hst (half square triangles)



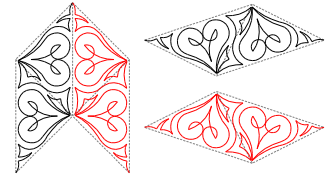
