

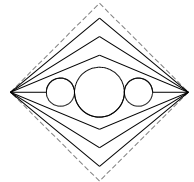
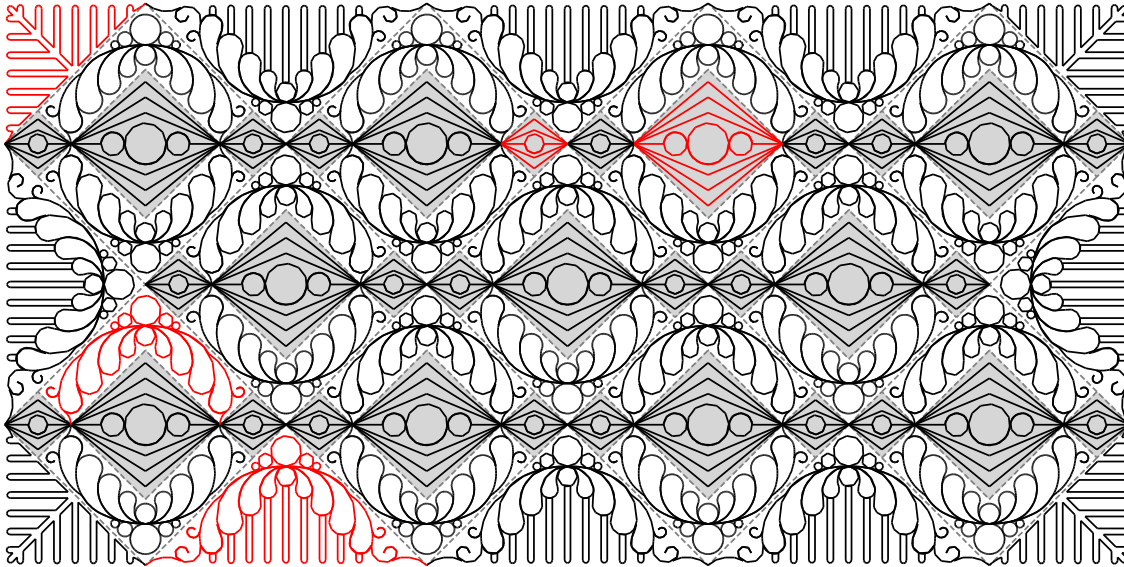

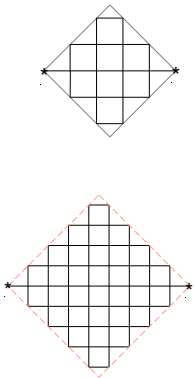

The size of the pieces in these blocks are quite specific. The small squares are 2" finished and the large squares are 4.5" finished (not 4" as one might expect). That makes the finished block 8.5" finished.

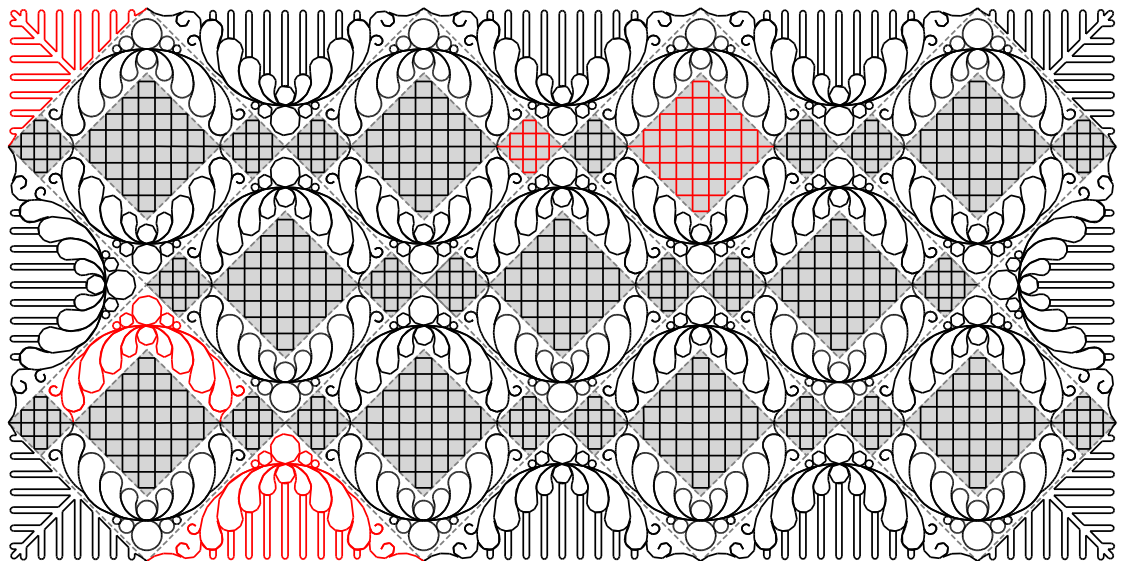
The pattern specific blocks are for the background areas. The designs in the squares can be whatever one chooses – giving great flexibility. Below shows how different options in the squares will make the overall effect different, even though the block specific pattern is the same.

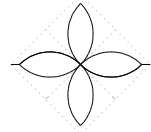
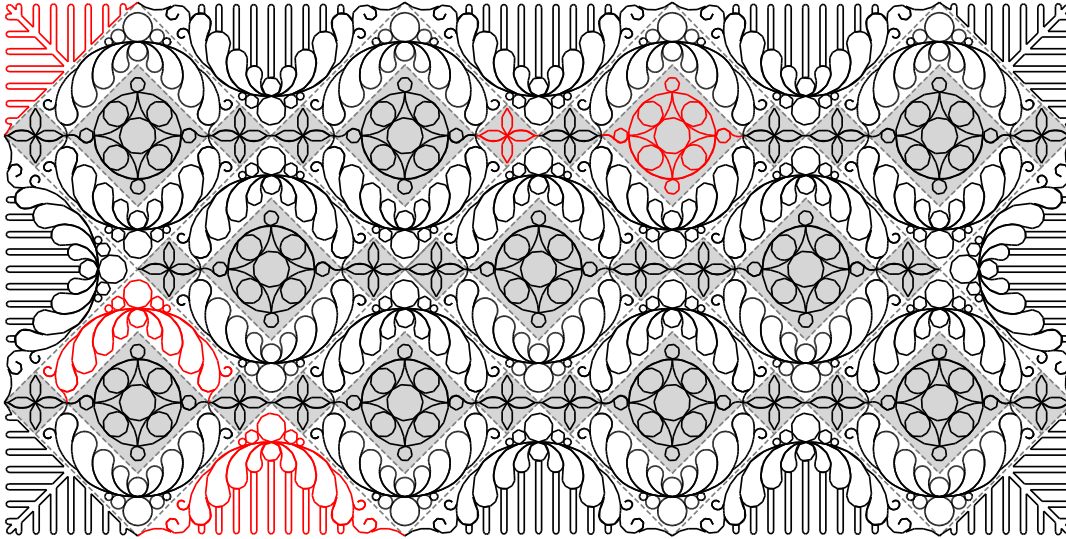


[X hatch squares p2p \(6\)](#)
- the x2.5 and x4.5 options were used.

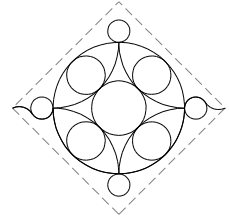

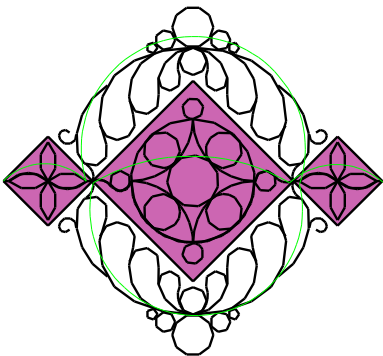

By using p2p designs the block can be quilted continuously – and the next block can also be quilted continuously from the previous. It will take 4/5 'clicks' to place the designs in each block – and they will be placed very accurately. I would suggest placing and quilting just 3 blocks at a time to start with as the fabric will migrate and designs further on may not be accurately positioned if going too far.
