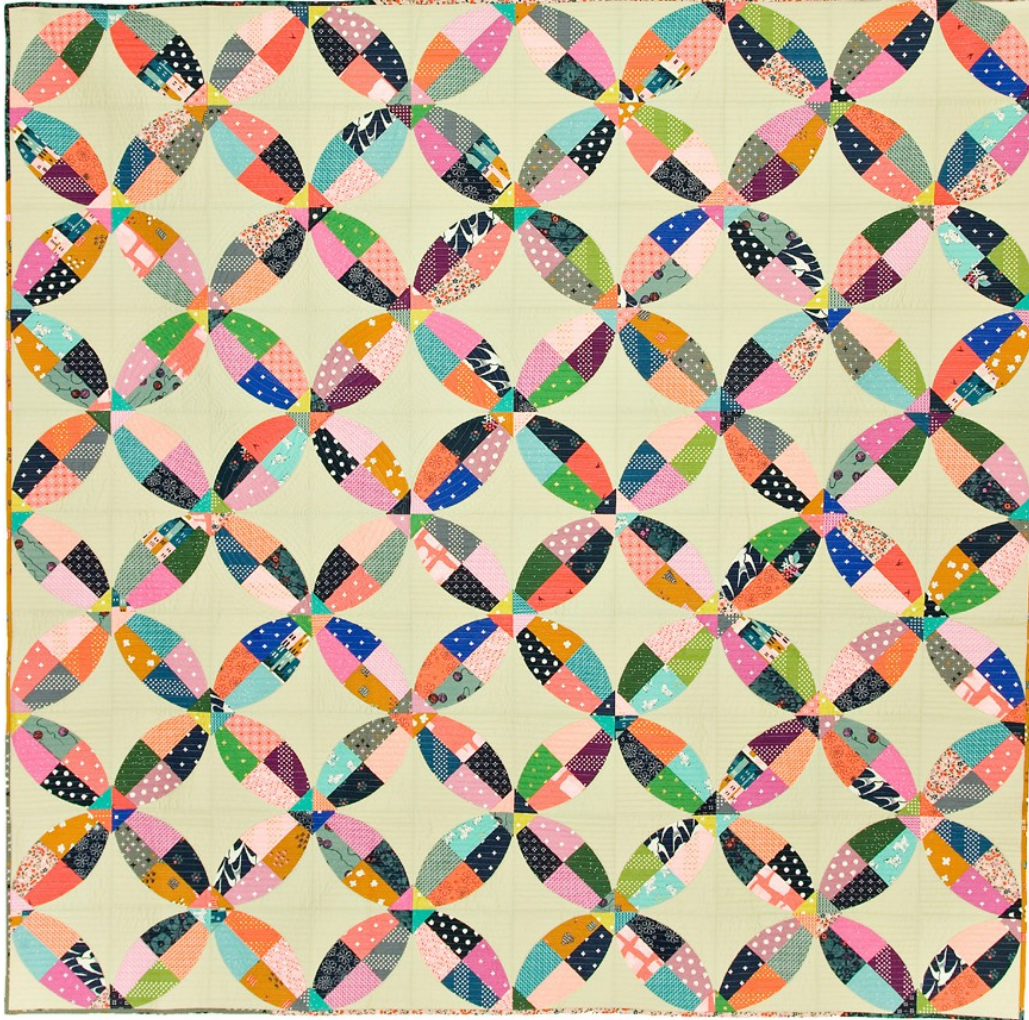

Quilting Plans & ideas

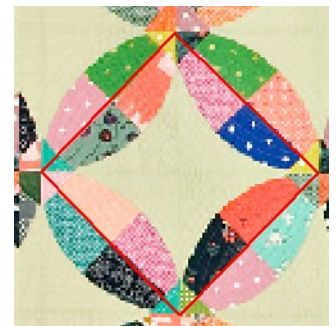


The negative spaces – the background areas - are great areas for quilting to be showcased!  
Most Double Wedding Ring quilting designs will fit here – but do audition a couple to start with before determining margins etc. The curves of this piecing design are different to many other DWR designs so auditioning is absolutely essential. Put in reference boundaries – the ones formed by the piecing lines and then try placing the design according to whichever method you prefer. Once decided upon use them for the whole quilt.

Placing the main DWR design:



1. Use the block piecing intersections as the corners for a square block. Margins will have to be quite large – but once determined are quickly repeatable. This sorts both sizing and rotational issues on the fly.  
The rotation of your design may influence which intersections you use – but you could always change the rotation of your design!





- Using p2psu.  
This is where you use the p2p function to place the design. The points used for registration are never sewn into – but again it sorts both sizing and rotational issues on the fly. *NB – not all machines are currently able to recognise this format*  
The initial audition will determine just where you need to 'click' for accurate sizing. Sometimes it is right on the piecing intersections, sometimes in just a little, sometimes in quite a lot. Perhaps use your hopper foot as guidance.

#### Placing the side and corner DWR designs.

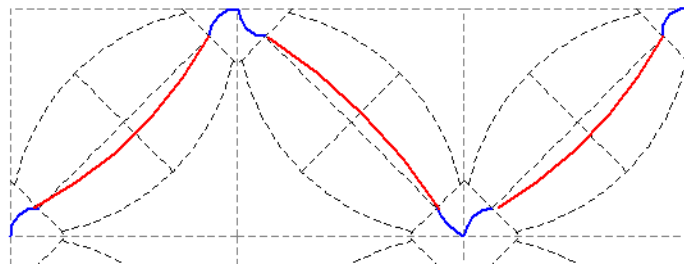
- If half and quarter DWR blocks are not available to you – you will need to trim or mask out the areas not required to be quilted.
- If part blocks are available and these are in p2p or p2psu formats – then this should be quick and easy – but again, audition first.
- If the part blocks are not p2p or p2psu designs, then use reference boundaries and manually place and size. You may not be able to place using standard triangle placements as the bottom margin may need to be = 0, while the side ones something different.

#### The non background areas.

These are made up of 4 curved pieces put together in the form of a 'bead' and triangles at each end of the bead. Where the blocks come together the 4 triangles form a square.

#### **Bead Note:**

- This bead is not quite the same proportion as the bead in Sew Kind of Wonderful's 'Urban Beads' pattern. The same quilting design could be used if sewn out higher than designed – but still may not fit as well as one would like.*
- For quilting convenience it is best if p2p bead quilting designs stop/start half way up each end of the block. Hence – I have adapted some of the Urban Bead designs to specifically fit this block.*



#### Concatenation.

There is a sequence which can be used across each block which allows for continuous quilting both across the block and across the quilt

The sequence is: triangle (beak to butt), bead, and then triangle again (the same one – but this time butt to beak)

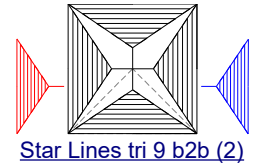
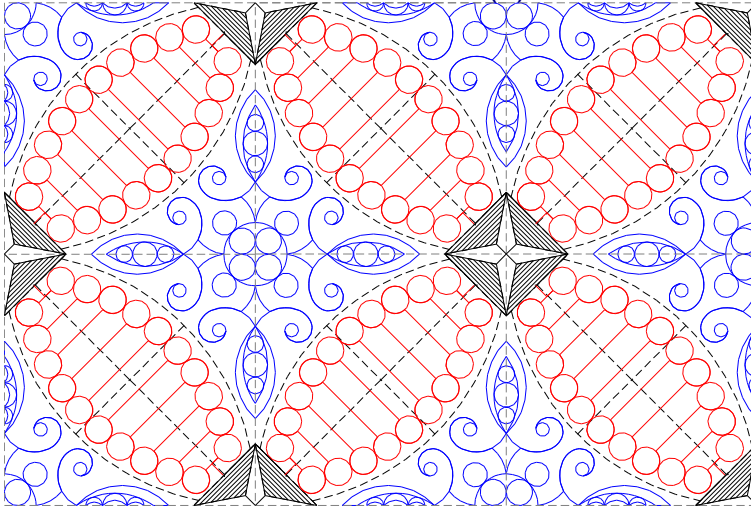
- if your machine has a concatenation feature – this is a great place to use it!
- If it does not – place the designs and set the sewing order.

*Note: for b2b triangles - check out triangles which are used for Flying Geese blocks*

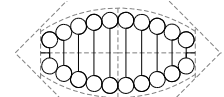
The quilting plans which follow are just some of the combinations available and more may be uploaded from time to time – play and create your own!

The dotted lines show the actual piecing lines which are created from the Sew Kind of Wonderful pattern.

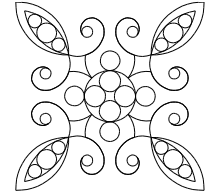

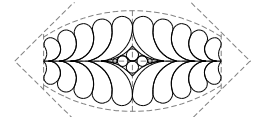
